Paul: Hello, Tomoko. Have you got any plans for this summer vacation?

Tomoko: Hi, Paul. I'm thinking about going to visit my grandparents who live nearby and seeing if they need any help around the house.

Paul: I guess you're going to be busy then. Do you often spend your summer vacation at your grandparents' house?

Tomoko: Not that often, but that's the plan for this year. Usually, people here in Japan go and stay at their relatives' house for a few days during the summer. We call this period *Obon*. It's a very special time for families here.

Paul: Oh, that sounds nice. What sort of things do people do during *Obon*?

Tomoko: *Obon* is celebrated in a range of ways, differing from region to region and even family to family. It's a time for us to remember and honor the dead by spending time with family and by doing things such as visiting and cleaning our ancestors' graves.

Paul: I see. So, is *Obon* always held at the same time each year?

Tomoko: It depends on the region, but it usually falls around the middle of July or August. People living in Tokyo, Yokohama or in the Tohoku region generally observe *Obon* in July, whereas other parts of Japan do so in August. A lot of companies close during this period and it feels kind of like a combination of Halloween and Christmas in the UK.

Paul: So, do you exchange gifts with each other like we do in the UK, too?

Tomoko: Not exactly. We do give gifts, called *ochugen* in this season to people we are close to, such as relatives and friends, but we also put gifts on our ancestors' tombs once we have cleaned them. We call these *osonae mono* and they typically consist of fresh fruit and other foods. We can also bring other things that the ⁽¹⁾deceased person liked, for example beer or green tea. We place these on the tomb after having washed and swept the grave and lighting ⁽²⁾incense.

Paul: Wow! What a rich tradition you have!

Tomoko: Yes. I think it is important to keep our traditions alive because it helps maintain a sense of connection to previous generations.

Paul: I totally agree. What are you bringing to your grandparents this *Obon*?

Tomoko: That's funny you mention that. My sister, Mina, just called me and told me that she bought a tablet for our grandparents with her summer bonus.

Paul: That's great! Are they good with technology?

Tomoko: No, they're not but neither am I. My sister is going to teach us all how to use it when we are all there together, because she works in the tech industry.

Paul: So, not only will you be able to see your family, but you will also be able to learn how to use a tablet!

Tomoko: Yeah, I am really looking forward to this summer vacation.
