Saori: Well, first I have to apply by email between January 17th and January 19th, giving my personal information, name, date of birth, passport number, etc. Then there is a^{*}ballot where 800 applicants will be chosen at random. If I'm successful, I'll receive an email by January 28th. If I'm not successful, there is another ballot in July, so I can try again.
