Jon: Hey Eddie. What are you up to?

Eddie: I'm just reading about Elon Musk's plan to build a full-size city on the surface of Mars. Can you believe that humans might actually have the chance to live on the Red Planet?

Jon: I've also heard about this. It sounds like a fun idea, but it also seems rather *1controversial. It's often in the news. I remember hearing that environmentalists believe it is having a negative impact on the local wildlife and ecosystem in Texas where the rockets are being launched. A lot of local animal and plant species are being endangered and there have been a few failed attempts where the rockets have exploded.

Eddie: There is always going to be risk of something going wrong when attempting something new, but in my opinion, it is an incredibly important venture for the future of life itself. We have so many challenges now on earth: overpopulation, food and energy shortages, and pollution. I think the benefits *2outweigh the risks. This project is also a way to help unite people. People are so divided at the moment, so this will inspire people. It says here that Elon Musk wants to move people's hearts.

Jon: Don't you think we should fix the problems we have here on earth first before going to another planet? Afterall, if we can't live here in a safe and sustainable way, how are we going to be able to live in space responsibly?

Eddie: What do you mean responsibly?

Jon: For example, space junk. It is said that there are approximately 27,000 pieces of *3debris in space now *4orbiting the earth. 23,000 of these are larger than a softball. Even tiny pieces can be extremely dangerous for objects such as satellites and the space station. They are very difficult to avoid and can be disastrous if they are hit. It seems that everywhere humans go we create pollution.

Eddie: I don't think you are looking at the bigger picture here, Jon. In order for our species to survive and **flourish**, we need to leave earth and explore space. Whilst I see your point, I'm afraid we have different opinions. There are many benefits of space exploration, too. Technologies used in space are often turned into products that we use as everyday products here on earth. Did you know the technology in your phone camera was developed in space? Also, science experiments performed in space have helped improve our understanding of medical conditions and satellites collect data that can be used to predict natural disasters such as typhoons.

Data from satellites can even be sent to emergency responders in the event of earthquakes and other disasters. The pros far outweigh the cons.

Jon: I guess you're right. Afterall, throughout history, humankind has always explored. From prehistoric humans first setting out from their caves to voyagers sailing to faraway lands, risking hardships to discover new places. The next logical step is venturing to outer space.
