Iwao Takamoto

You might not know the name Iwao Takamoto, but you are probably familiar with his animated creations. Scooby-Doo became his most famous character, which he developed in the later part of his career. Born in 1925 in Los Angeles, California to Japanese parents who had immigrated to the US, he and his family were sent to an *1 internment camp after the bombing of Pearl Harbor. It was not the happiest place to grow up, but there his passion for drawing began. After the war, he bought two pads of paper and filled them with drawings, bringing them to an interview at Walt Disney Studios. After only fifteen minutes, Takamoto was offered his first animation job. He went on to work on several famous movies there like *One Hundred and One Dalmatians* and *Lady and the Tramp*. It was at Hanna-Barbera Productions, another animation studio, where his most popular characters, including Scooby-Doo, came to life.


