Host: Today we are talking with Mark Johnson, an expert in streaming music who writes for *Music Monthly Magazine*. He has worked with companies such as Spotify, Apple Music, and Amazon Music. Welcome to the show, Mark.

Mark: Thank you for having me.

Host: So, Mark, can you tell us about the good points of streaming?

Mark: One benefit that comes to mind is its convenience and availability. Services like the ones you mentioned offer access to millions of songs, albums, and playlists from various ^{*1}genres and artists.

Host: That's true. When I was a kid, I never imagined being able to listen to so much music. Not only are there millions of songs, but you can find any content you want in seconds. And on top of that, you can listen on multiple devices without needing to download.

Mark: Exactly. And these companies also give the customer a personalized experience.

Host: How do they do that?

Mark: The services know what you like, or at least what you listen to, based on your listening habits. By using ^{*2}algorithms, they recommend new music for you. These recommendations help you explore playlists made by other users and discover new or less popular artists.

Host: I totally agree. I listen to more international music now than before. However, one downside is that I often worry about the cost. Paying a monthly fee adds up.

Mark: It can be a bit pricey over time. There are plans that people can afford, like family plans, and student discounts, but users need to continue subscribing each month. Another negative is that artists earn less per stream compared to physical CD sales.

Host: And the users don't actually own the music, do they?

Mark: Correct. They only have access as long as they continue to pay. So, in a way, they are borrowing the music.

Host: Well, streaming music is certainly convenient, but understanding the ^{*3}pros and cons can help users make better decisions about how they enjoy their music.
