The version that most people know, especially in Western countries, is Frenchman Charles Perrault’s, published in 1697. It is from this publication that ideas like the fairy godmother, the pumpkin carriage, and the slipper made of glass appear for the first time. Of course, the ending is like the original, which is probably one of the reasons why it remains such a popular tale.
