Dear MGU AIRways,

I am writing to make an official complaint as I was charged a baggage fee during my recent flight with your airline.

On April 25, 2025, I traveled on MGU AIRways flight number MG555 from London to Tokyo. According to the cabin baggage policy on your website, passengers are allowed one item with maximum dimensions of 56 cm x 36 cm x 23 cm, and another one not over 40 cm x 30 cm x 10 cm. The policy states the combined weight limit is 7 kg. As a frequent traveler, I was careful to follow these requirements. However, when I arrived at the boarding gate, MGU AIRways staff told me that my backpack, small suitcase, and laptop were counted as three separate items, even though I had them tied together. I was not aware that tying bags together did not reduce the number of items.

I would like a refund for the fee that I was charged. I look forward to hearing back from you soon.

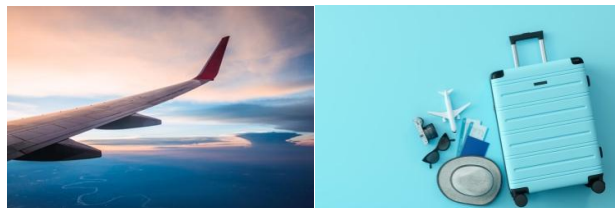

- MGU AIRways allows passengers to carry a limited amount of cabin baggage.
- Your cabin baggage must meet the size and weight restrictions, maximum 7 kg.
- Prohibited items should not be included in your cabin baggage.
