Abraham Lincoln was born in 1809 in the U.S. When he was a child, he often enjoyed reading books. His family was not rich, so ① . Instead, he always borrowed books from other people. He respected George Washington, the first U.S. president, because Washington believed in \*equality and freedom for everyone. Lincoln also borrowed a book about him and ②read it many times.

When Lincoln was nineteen, he went to the South U.S. to get money. When he arrived there, he saw something \*terrible. Many \*Black people, including young children, were brought to the South U.S. from Africa by ship to work in fields as \*slaves. They were bought by \*Whites and even \*whipped like horses to \*increase their work speed. After seeing ③these things, Lincoln realized that the U.S. was not a country that supported equality and freedom.

After that, Lincoln worked hard to become a \*legislator, just like his hero, Washington. While Lincoln was a legislator, the number of slaves increased. In 1860, there were about 8,000,000 Whites and about 4,000,000 slaves in the South U.S. Many people in the North U.S. said the government should end the slave system. However, people in the South U.S. needed slaves for their farms. Because of this, they didn't agree with 4the idea of the people in the North U.S.

While the North U.S. and South U.S. were fighting, Lincoln became president. Then, the \*Civil War between the two sides started in 1861. At first, the South U.S. \*armies were stronger than the North U.S. armies, and many people were killed. Lincoln didn't want to break the country in half. He tried to remind everyone about equality and freedom for all, as the \*Declaration of Independence said in 1776. In 1863, he \*issued the \*Emancipation Proclamation. This \*freed the slaves in the South U.S. The freed slaves joined the North armies, and they won the war.

Because of the Emancipation Proclamation, Americans again began working to create a country that supported equality and freedom for everyone. Today, Lincoln's goal is still a great goal for many countries around the world.
